

Swimmers:

Staying safe around Burnham Overy Staithe and Scolt Head Island

Be seen!



1. Wells Bar high tide time: **one** hour either side is safest
2. Make sure you can be seen: wear a brightly coloured swimming hat and a fluorescent tow float
3. Stay near the land: in particular **avoid** the area near the Harbour Mouth (**red circle**), keeping well out of the way of anything that is moving that could hit you
4. Calling for help: keep fully charged mobile phone in a waterproof pouch around your neck
5. Take care when entering the water: you will need time to acclimatise to the cold water
